Youth Sailing - Rob Ritchie provided a status report for the Youth Sailing program. Rob reported that it will appear in the FDL Rec Guide again this year. The Dock project for Youth Sailing will get approval from the DNR.

Boat repair dates for lasers has not yet been assigned but will be announced at the April meeting. Given that the youth sailing program is a Yacht Club program, work hours on the program can be used for the YC requirements.

Social event committee - Dave Whealon reported that the committee met on February 26th. The committee selected the weekend of June 2 & 3 to get more sailors from the harbor to get involved with the Sailing Club. 
